Luke 24: 1-12 – *The Death and Resurrection of Jesus* – The women found the stone rolled away and the tomb empty. Two men in bright raiment then appeared to them and said that Jesus had risen. They rushed to the disciples who disbelieved their tale, but Peter ran to the tomb, – "stooping and looking in, he saw the linen clothes by themselves; then he went home amazed at what had happened."
