Matthew 22: 15-22 - The Pharisees plotted to entrap Jesus and asked him, – “Is it lawful to pay taxes to the emperor or not?” (v17) Jesus replied, – “Give therefore to the emperor the things that are the emperor’s, and to God the things that are God’s.” (v21)
