Members of St. Martin's Choir have donated £250.00 towards the construction of a new church primary school at St. Paul's Church, Kawama. The site is located within the grounds of an Anglican church, in a township south of Ndola and when complete the new school at Kawama will provide education for 100 young children who otherwise would be deprived of any primary education. The project is being masterminded by Hands of Compassion, a UK charity that is well-known to St. Martin's and who is now working with the Anglican Diocese of Central Zambia on this and other school developments.

Roof Repairs - this work has now started and we have been informed that unfortunately the completion date has been put back to Friday 20 September. During this period the church will remain closed except for Sunday Services, which means that there will be no Toddlers on Tuesdays, no Café on Wednesdays and no mid - week Holy Communion on Thursdays.
