Readings

Acts 10.34-43

In this passage, Peter speaks to those gathered at the house of Cornelius, a centurion, with a summary of his teaching about Jesus. Peter tells them how he witnessed the death and resurrection of Jesus and was commissioned to preach and teach everyone – both Jews and Gentiles – that Jesus is the one appointed by God and spoken by the prophets.

1 Corinthians 15.19-26

Paul asserts his certainty about the resurrection. Just as it is certain that all people (ie descendants of Adam) will die, so it is certain that those who are born again in Christ will be made alive. Paul describes the Second Coming of Christ and the final reign of God.

John 20.1-18

Mary Magdalene finds the tomb empty. She fetches Peter and John to come and see. When they have left she encounters the risen Jesus, and mistakes Him for the gardener but then recognizes Him when Jesus calls her by her name. Mary then goes to tell the others.
