Readings

Acts 12.1-11

Peter has been imprisoned by King Herod Agrippa . The church prayed fervently for Peter's release. An angel of the Lord miraculously frees Peter leading him past the guards and out of the prison. Peter, initially disoriented, realized he had been delivered and went to the house where the church was praying.

Matthew 16.13-19

In this passage, Jesus asks the disciples: "Who do people say that I am?" Impetuous Simon, always quick to speak out, confesses Jesus as the Messiah. It is an inspired confession. He is rewarded with a new name, Peter, meaning the rock, upon which Jesus predicts the Church will be built.
