

Paul greets the Colossians and affirms their faith. He encourages them to be strong and to do what pleases God.

Luke 10.25-37

This passage in Luke's Gospel includes the Parable of the Good Samaritan. One of the most well known of Jesus' Parables. Jesus tells the parable in answer to the question "Who is my neighbour?". Jesus tells us that it is through our actions that real love is shown. In this parable a number of people who might have been expected to care for someone in need pass by, and it is the person least expected to help, who stops and provides an act of love and care.
