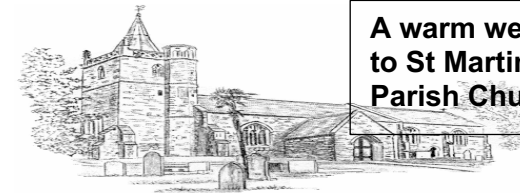

Genesis 18.1-15

Abraham offers hospitality to three travellers. As they eat together, one of the travellers tells Abraham that Sarah will give birth to a son. Sarah overhears this and laughs because she is beyond child bearing age.

Romans 5.1-8

Through faith our relationship with God has been restored and that brings peace. Paul reflects on what this experience of God's grace means. He speaks of testing endurance and hope. God loves his people so much that he sent his Son to die for us all even though we are sinners.

Matthew 9.35-10.8

Jesus travels around preaching and healing. He feels pity for the crowds of people who seem worried and helpless. He prays to the Father for workers to be sent out to minister to people in their need. Jesus commissions his twelve disciples to go out to the people of Israel to preach and heal.
