

Isaiah 42.1-9

This passage known as the Second Song of the Servant is spoken by
the servant who is Israel. Israel will be restored and brought back to
God and will also become a light to the nations, the means of bringing
God's salvation to all parts of the earth.

1 Corinthians 1.1-9

Paul follows his greeting at the beginning of this letter with a passage
giving thanks for the members of the church in Corinth and their firm
faith. He continually emphasizes their relationship to God through
Christ.

John 1.29-42

John the Baptist points out Jesus as the Chosen One of God. When
John repeats this the next day, two of his disciples – one of whom is
Andrew - begin to follow Jesus. Andrew fetches his brother, telling him
he has found the Messiah. Simon is given the name Cephas (Peter, the
rock) by Jesus.
