Please continue to pray for all those affected by the current situation in Afghanistan.

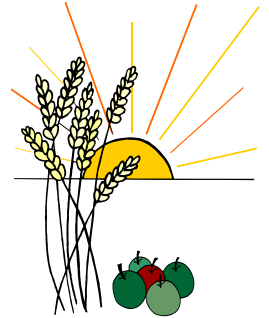
